<b>4.</b>	Approval of the Police and Fire Commission minutes from the meeting held December 3, 2019. Motion by Commissioner Springob, seconded by Commissioner Brown. Motion carries with Commissioner Clark abstaining.	
<b>5.</b>	<p><b>Greenfield Police Department Report (Chief Johnson):</b> Chief Johnson briefed the Commission about recent developments within the Police Department. In the month of December, the department saw an uptick in retail thefts at Meijer, Kohls and Walmart. The command staff decided to implement a visible police presence at each store for two weeks, from 12:00PM to 8:00PM, to deter these crimes. The department will be presenting the collected data to the businesses.</p> <p>There was a bank robbery at Educator’s Credit Union and the suspects were caught. The CIB was the lead investigative team for the shooting at Waukesha South High School. The Waukesha County District Attorney complimented the department on our investigation. The fifth referendum officer was sworn in today and three of our officers graduated the Academy last Friday, 12/20/19.</p> <p>Commissioner Cashmore inquired about the upcoming 2020 DNC. Captain Lindstrom is the contact for our agency and has had several meetings with MPD. There is a reimbursement agreement in place; the final contract is in the works. Greenfield’s SWAT team will be there every day and the department has committed 17 officers.</p>
