The City of Greenfield is actively addressing ways to reduce disease transmission throughout the community as a result of the COVID-19 public health emergency. This includes, but is not limited to, the cancellation, suspension, and postponement of activities across many departments in the City of Greenfield.

After careful consideration, the City of Greenfield will postpone or cancel ALL Parks and Recreation Programs, events and community rental of facilities effective Monday March 16, 2020 until further notice.

This is in compliance with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) guidance regarding large gatherings and the benefits of social distancing in minimizing community spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19).

Refunds or credits for the affected programs, events or rentals will be pro-rated or refunded in whole as necessary.

We ask for your patience as this could take a few weeks to process and issue refund checks.

The City of Greenfield continues to monitor this situation based on guidance from the CDC and DHS and will provide updates as needed if additional adjustments are warranted. As a reminder please read and follow the following preventative measures that will significantly limit spread of germs and help avoid illness.
